**MEET THE MCLEODS!**

The Music Search Advisory Team and the Personnel Committee are delighted to present Keith McLeod as our candidate for the position of Minister of Music.

Keith comes from a military background. His father's career was in the United States Air Force, so he has lived in many places. Born in Tucson, Arizona, and raised in California, his roots are primarily western. His family moved to the South in 1979, where he completed his undergraduate Degree in Music Theory and Composition at Samford University in 1983. His Masters Degree in Music comes from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas.

Keith and his wife, Lisa, have been married for 14 years. Currently, Lisa works in the electronic sales industry in Huntsville. Keith's daughter, Emily, is a music student at Samford University. (Thus the picture of Keith and Emily backstage before she performed in a musical!)

Keith has served as a full-time Minister of Music in three churches in Alabama and Florida. Prior to that, during his student days he served as a part-time Minister of Music in three different churches in Alabama, Texas, and Florida. For the last fifteen years, Keith has served as minister of Music and Worship at Locust Grove Baptist Church in New Market, Alabama.

Should Keith join us at Brookwood, he would oversee the entire music ministry other than the second worship service. (He and Ethan have already hit it off and have discussed ways that they can be of creative assistance to each other.)

Tonight after church supper, members of the Music Search Team will offer their thoughts about Keith and the process through which God has led us. We will host a meet-and-greet with Keith and Lisa this Saturday from 1:00-2:30 in the SOC. On Sunday morning, Keith will lead the music and choir and sing in the first service, and he will offer a song in the second service as well. At the end of both services we will hold a special called business meeting to vote on Keith.

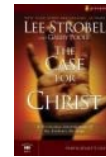
